



## Sticks in a Can

This book project presentation allows you to show your classmates just how much you know about the book you read.

### Materials

- empty juice can (rinsed)
- decorative adhesive paper
- scissors
- colored permanent markers
- wooden craft sticks
- black fine-tip marker



### Directions

1. Cut a strip of adhesive paper to wrap around the juice can.
2. Use the permanent markers to decorate the outside of the can with the title and author of your book as well as other decorations related to the story.
3. On each of several craft sticks, use a fine-tip marker to write a character name, a name of a location, or an object from the book you read. \* You must include 5 elements from the book.
4. Place the sticks into the can so that the writing cannot be seen.
5. For your presentation, ask each of your classmates to pass the can and, in turn, select a craft stick.
6. Ask each classmate to read the words on the craft stick to the class.
7. Now it's your turn to explain how this character, location, or object relates to the story you read.
8. When you have explained the words on all of the craft sticks, be sure to invite your classmates to ask questions they have about the story.
